FEBRUARY 28 LAST DAY TO PAY TAXES AT THE TOWNSHIP

The treasurer will have extended hours of 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, February 28**. This is the **last day** the township can accept tax payments before being returned as delinquent to the county treasurer. Postmarks are <u>NOT accepted</u>.
